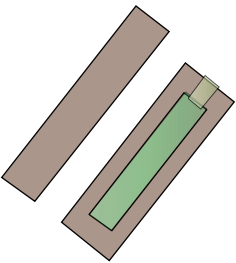

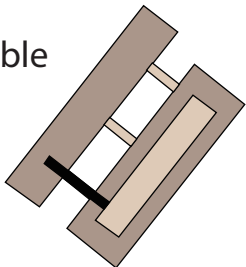

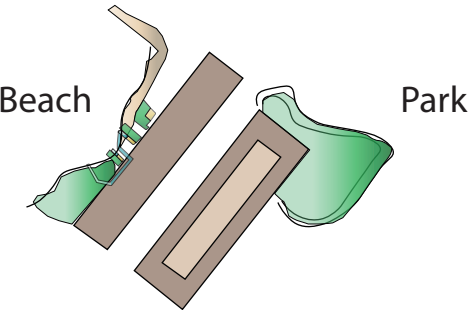

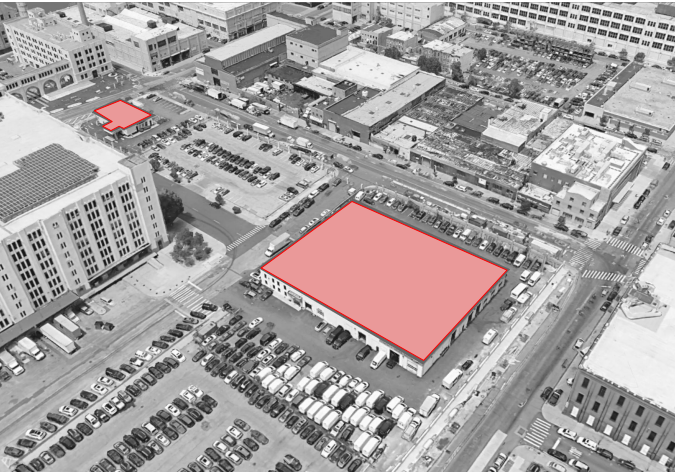
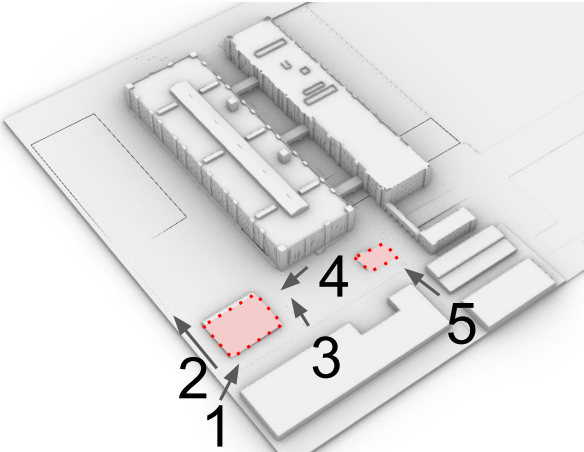
Visibility Diagram / Site Analysis



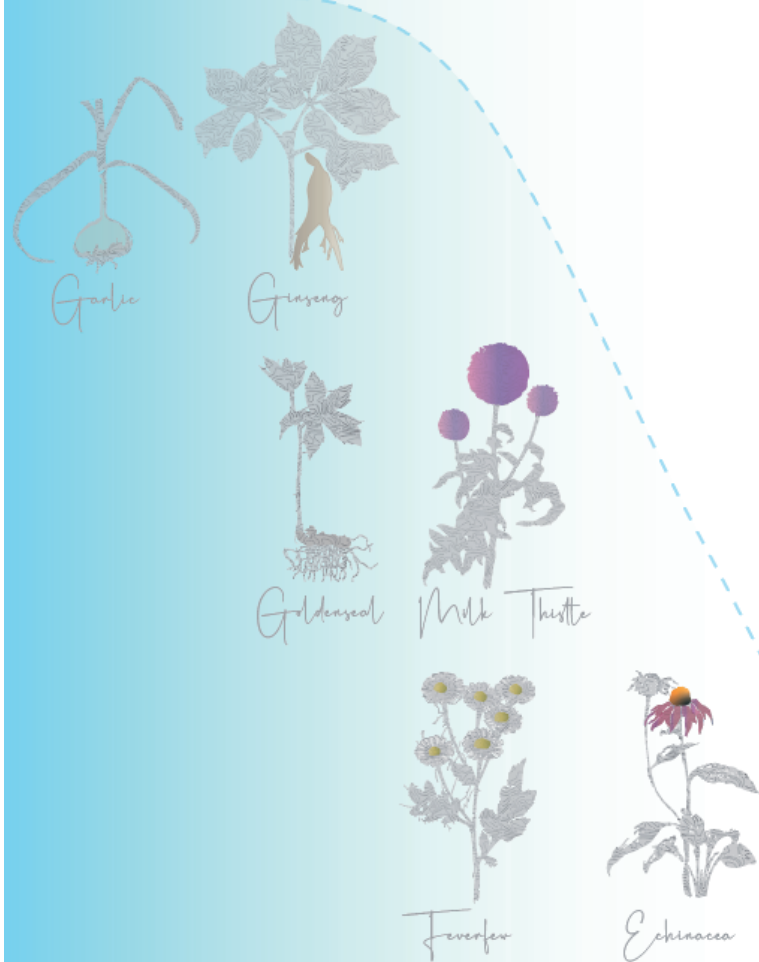

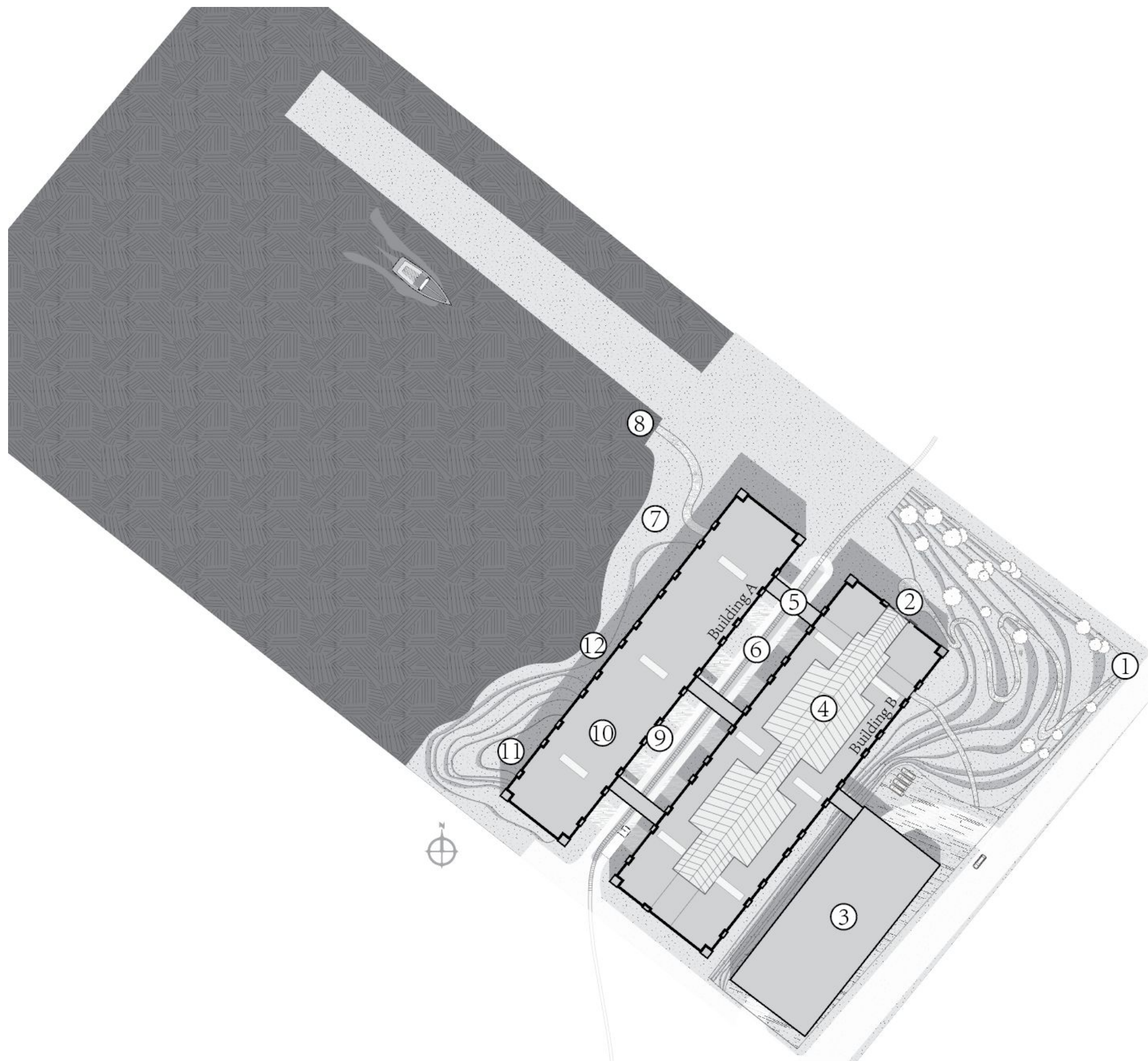
