### **FORMAT:**

Four-Ball Stroke Play competition conducted over 18 holes.

**REGISTRATION:** Players are to report to their assigned starting tees, ready to play, 10 minutes before their starting time. **There will be no formal check-in or call to the tee.**

**STARTING TIMES:** Morning tee times will begin at 8:00 a.m. off No. 1. Starting times & groupings can be [FOUND HERE](#).

**TIES:** In the event of a tie for the Championship, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off immediately after scores are finalized.

**DMDS:** The use of distance-measuring devices (DMD) to measure distance only (Rule 4.3) is permitted in this MSGA championship.

**PACE OF PLAY:** It is a condition that player must play without undue delay and in accordance with guidelines established by committee. Guidelines will be distributed upon arrival at the course.

**PRACTICE ROUNDS:** Practice rounds can be scheduled by calling the Golf Shop at 410-343-4653. The cost will be \$70 plus tax for players in the tournament. Guest fees for those who would also like to play but are not competing in the event will cost \$145 plus tax. Credit card will be the only form of payment accepted.

**PRACTICE FACILITIES/RANGE BALLS:** The practice range opens one hour before the first starting time, weather permitting. Range balls will be set up at the practice range and are complimentary for competitors before the round or a play-off. Please allow time to get from the range to No.1.

**CADDIES:** Caddies are permitted; however, you are responsible for making your own arrangements for a caddie.

**CARTS:** Automotive transportation is permitted for players and caddies. **Carts are included in the entry fee.** *A player and his caddie may ride in a golf cart during a round, but both may not ride at the same time.* **Spectator Carts** will not be permitted except for a spectator who can provide an issued and active Handicap Permit.

**CODE OF CONDUCT:** As set forth in the MSGA application, the code of conduct applies to all MSGA Qualifying and Championships.

**PERSONAL APPEARANCE:** Contestants and caddies must be neat in appearance. Blue jeans, designer jeans, t-shirts, and tank tops are prohibited. Shorts must be mid-thigh. Golf shirts with a traditional or mock collar are required.

**FOOD SERVICE:** A limited menu will be available for purchase. Credit card only, no cash will be accepted.
