Graduation Week Info

Seniors,

You have made it!!! Congratulations!

This week is all about celebrating, but responsibly. Do not put your participation in graduation in danger by making a poor choice.

Monday, June 4th - Senior Check-Out (Mandatory)

- Be in the Gym by 8am
- The following **must** be done prior to check-out:
 - Return all text books to Media Center
 - Pay all library fines and chromebook fees to School Bookkeeper (Clarissa Gonzalez)
 - Pay all balances to Cafeteria/Food services
 - Serve all remaining lunch detentions prior to check-out (any unserved lunch detentions must be served today (06/04) in order to complete check-out)
 - Complete Senior Exit Survey - Will be e-mailed to your school e-mail
- Students attending Grad Nite will receive their mandatory t-shirt
- Once students complete check-out they must leave campus

Tuesday, June 5th - Cap & Gown and Graduation Tickets (Mandatory)

- Report to cap and gown distribution at 8:00 at front of school
- Students who have not purchased a cap and gown can buy them for \$65 **cash only**, after cap and gown order distribution ends
- When picking up tickets, students will also receive:
 - Parking Pass (one per graduate, based on side)
 - A-G Sash, if earned
- Extra ticket pick-up line will begin after cap and gown distribution for students requesting additional tickets
 - Line up, single file
 - If you cut the line you will not get any extra tickets
 - You may go through the line repeatedly until we run out

Wednesday, June 6th - Graduation Practice (MANDATORY)

- Be in the Gym by 7:30am
- Check the list on the wall for seat assignments
- Wear comfortable clothes and please be sure to bring the shoes you plan to wear for the graduation ceremony
- Bring sunscreen, water, hat, etc... - you will be on the field for an hour or more in the middle of the day.

Thursday, June 7th - Grad Nite

- Check In: 5pm PVHS Gym
 - Park or be dropped off in the Gym Parking Lot.
 - Students who are late and miss check-in may miss the bus, and therefore may not be able to attend - as a reminder **there are no refunds for any reason.**
 - Administration or designees will search each senior and their belongings as they enter the gym.
 - **Ok** to bring
 - Backpack
 - Purse
 - Snack for the ride. Snacks must be consumed either in the gym or on the bus. They cannot be taken into the park
 - One unopened beverage
 - One or two **sealed** snacks
 - Money for additional food, beverages, and souvenirs at the park (4 hours of unlimited meals are included with your ticket)
 - **Not Ok** to bring
 - Tobacco, drugs, alcohol, weapons
 - Selfie-Sticks
 - Drones
 - Food, Beverages, Gum (Six Flags does not allow outside food or beverages for Grad Nite students)

Friday, June 8th - Graduation

- Be in the Gym by 4pm
 - Enter through fire lane by J Building
- Stadium gates open at 4pm (we recommend you come with your family)
- Extra parking for families is at Menifee Valley Middle School with a shuttle to Paloma's bus loop.
- Handicap parking is in the front of both student and staff lot - Must have a graduation parking pass.
- All students will be searched by District Admin
 - Graduates may **NOT** have with them:
 - Cell phones
 - Electronics
 - Bags/Purses
 - Food/drink items
 - Note: Water will be provided in the gym
 - Graduates **MAY** have with them:
 - Wallets
 - Car Keys
 - Sunglasses
