
USED TO FORM



Repeated events in the past that we don't do anymore.

USED TO with the base form of the verb



I played tennis regularly in the past but now I don't.

QUESTIONS

Don't double the last consonant

We form a question with DID and the spelling of USED TO changes to USE TO.



Which sports DID you USE TO play?

NEGATIVES

The spelling also changes for the negative.



WOULD

We use WOULD to express regular past events with dynamic verbs.

When I was young I WOULD GO fishing with my father every summer.

WOULD is much less common than USED TO in spoken English.
