Creating Aliases

```
alias [name [=value] ]
```

List or create aliases.

Use name=value to create a new alias.

Aliases

- Fix Typos

```
$ alias grpe='grep'
```

- Make Linux behave like another OS.

```
$ alias cls='clear'
```

Removing Aliases

unalias name

Remove the “name” alias.

unalias -a

Remove all aliases

Persisting Aliases

- Add aliases to your personal initialization files.
 - `.bash_profile`
