



ECHEVERIA AGAVOIDES
“LIPSTICK ECHEVERIA”

IDEAL LIGHT

Full sun to partial sun

WINTER HARDINESS

Not frost tolerant - protect from freezing

PROPAGATION METHODS

Stem cuttings, leaves, or offsets

WATER NEEDS

Water only when soil is dry

MATURE SIZE

6 inches tall | 6 inches wide

ADDITIONAL NOTES

This beautiful Echeveria really shows off when it's been happily "stressed." Its lime green leaves have red edges, giving it the nickname "Lipstick," but this succulent gets its species name from the Agave-like shape of its leaves.

Watch for red flowers in the last spring to early summer.
