Award Criteria Water Challenge 2022-2023

The Winners of Water Challenge are selected in accordance with the following award criteria: credibility, idea, team, sustainability and effect on water resource management and water supply.

Credibility

The jury will for example judge if the team seems very knowledgeable within the business area and has made good assumptions for managing risk. The business concept has been tested and verified with good results against several key players. There is also a sustainability perspective that is well presented.

Sustainability

The jury will examine if the business concept is financially, environmentally or socially sustainable. The sustainable aspect is very clear and well though out. It can make a big positiv impact in its field at local, national or international level. The team has demonstrated knowledge of the sustainability aspects by, for example, addressing the Global Goals or problems they solve with their service/product.



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The jury will look if the business concept is well presented and shows height of innovation and has commercial potential to become a sustainable business. A clear and credible plan exists for how the business concept will scale to other markets, areas of use or additional customer segments.

Team

The jury will look at if the team seems to have the required competence, or a plan to obtain that competence. Further, the team shows great drive, execution and sustainable values.

Effect Water Resource Management and Supply

The jury will examine if the participants have shown that their business idea is able to make a significant impact on water resource management and sustainable water supply.
