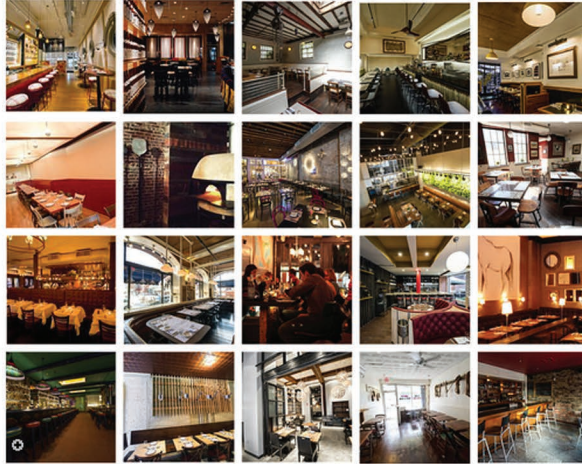


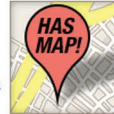

**THE MEATBALL SHOP**

The Meatball Shop is a great place to go if you're nursing a hangover, because you can either dive head first into a big plate of carbs, or order an assortment of proteins and vegetables, all for very little money. The new Upper East Side location is the first Meatball Shop to offer brunch. The options include balls Benedict, "smash bun" French toast, and a version of biscuits and gravy made with meatballs.

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
