The abovementioned plans have been scrutinised, and although they are in order insofar as this Department is concerned, they must be endorsed that approval must not be construed as meaning that a licence, or permission to accommodate any Bantu in these quarters will be granted when the building is completed.

It will be appreciated if, in addition you will endorse the plans as follows:-

"In accordance with the Council's resolution of 22nd February 1966, a licence to accommodate Bantu in the building will be considered on the following basis:-

- (i) 1 Boiler Attendant.
- (ii) l Watchman.
- (iii) 1 Bantu servant irrespective of sex, whether employed by the owner or a tenant, for every full unit of 5 flats.
- (iv) l Bantu servant irrespective of sex for every full unit of 10 flats for compassionate cases."

At the next meeting of my Committee authority will be sought for the issue of a licence by this Department on the above basis if and when the building is complete.
