ADDITIONAL NOTES

This beautiful purple succulent shows off when it is "happily stressed" in cold weather or lots of sun. It is winter hardy, making it the perfect accent for rock or outdoor container gardens.

It it is deer resistant, and its flowers attract bees and butterflies.

'Pacific Devil's Food' is monocarpic, meaning that it blooms once and then dies. Flowering occurs in the late summer or fall.
