



KALANCHOE LUCIAE
“FLAPJACK”

IDEAL LIGHT

Full sun to partial sun

WINTER HARDINESS

Not frost tolerant - protect from freezing

PROPAGATION METHODS

Cuttings, leaves, and offsets

WATER NEEDS

Water only when soil is dry

MATURE SIZE

2 feet tall | 3 feet wide

ADDITIONAL NOTES

Kalanchoe luciae has smooth flat leaves that blush a beautiful red with the right amount of sunlight. It is monocarpic, but easily propagates from offsets.

It has yellow flowers that bloom in late Winter to early Spring.

It is often mistaken for Kalanchoe thyrsiflora.
