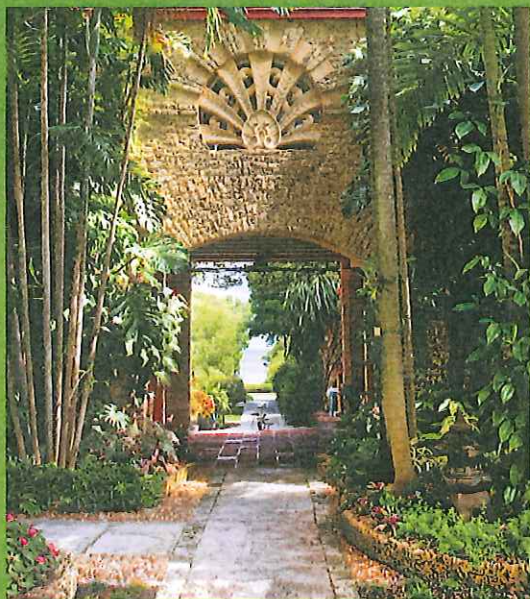
New Spring Dishes

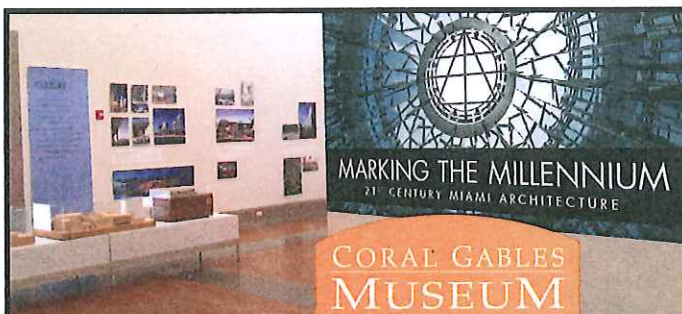
