

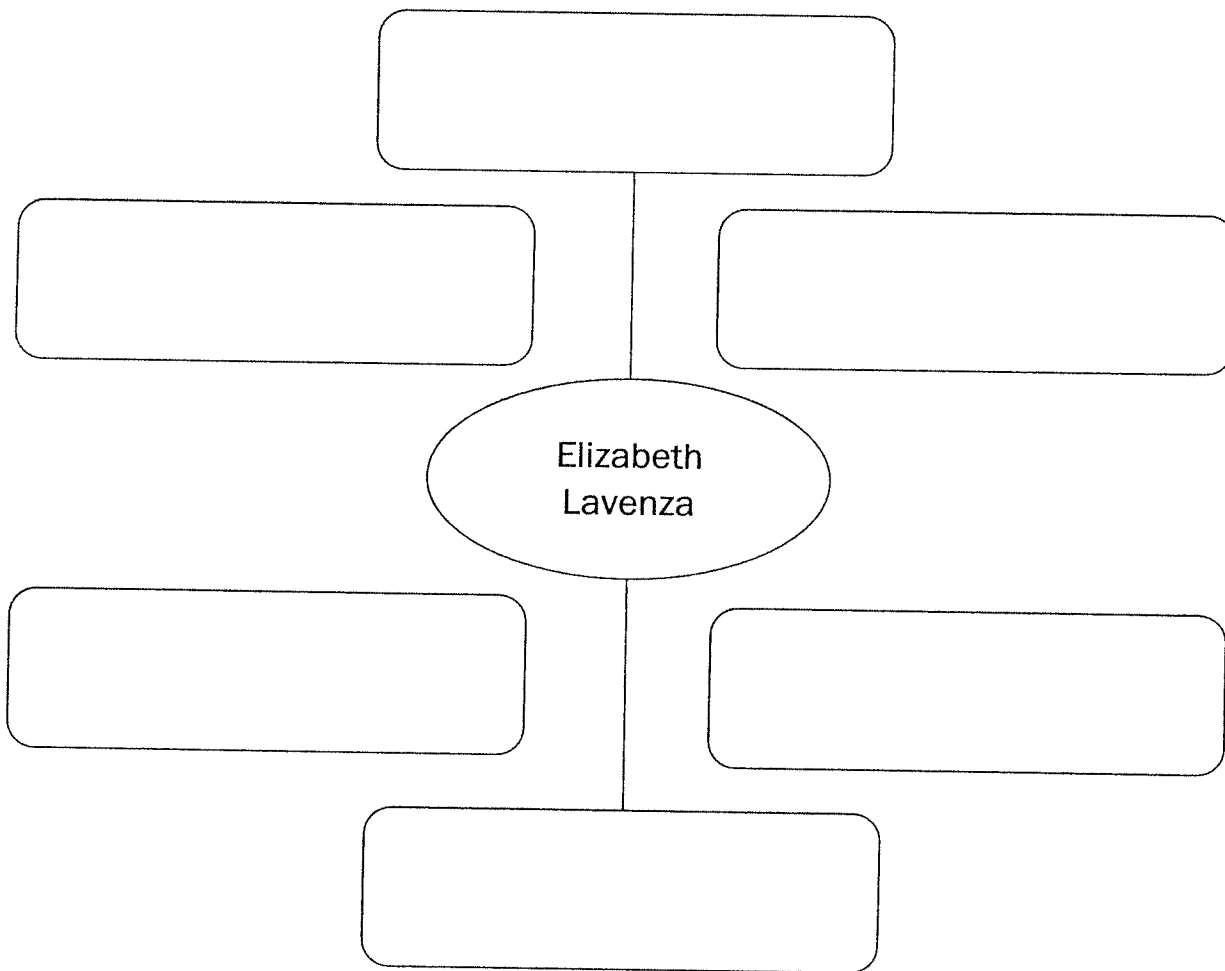
Chapters One – Two

Standards Focus: Character Interactions

A **main character**, or *protagonist*, is the central figure in a literary work. Most of the novel's events revolve around this person. **Subordinate characters** also appear in a literary work, but not to the extent of the protagonist. Subordinate characters frequently interact with or influence the main character. These interactions can shed light on the main character and affect the work's plot.

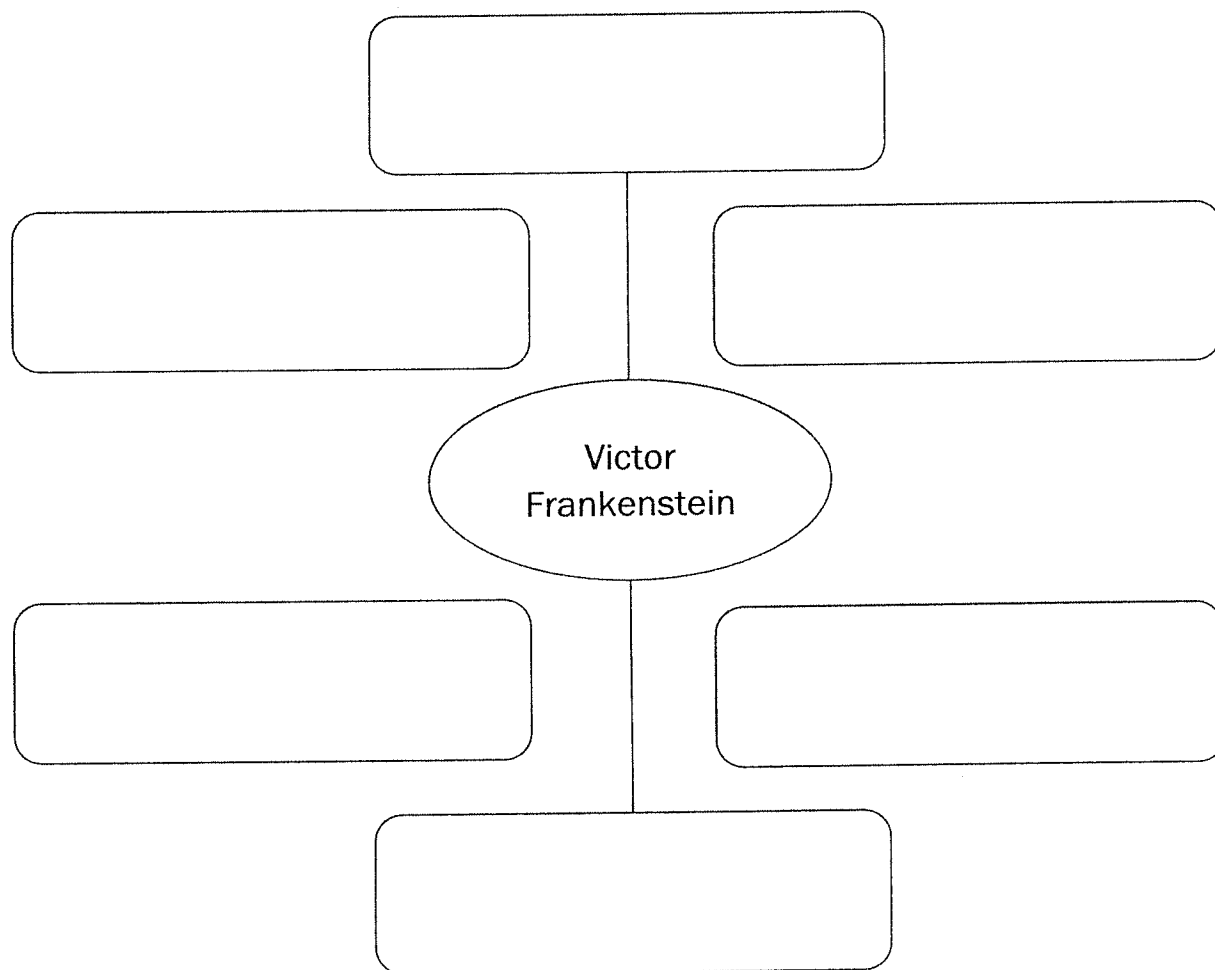
