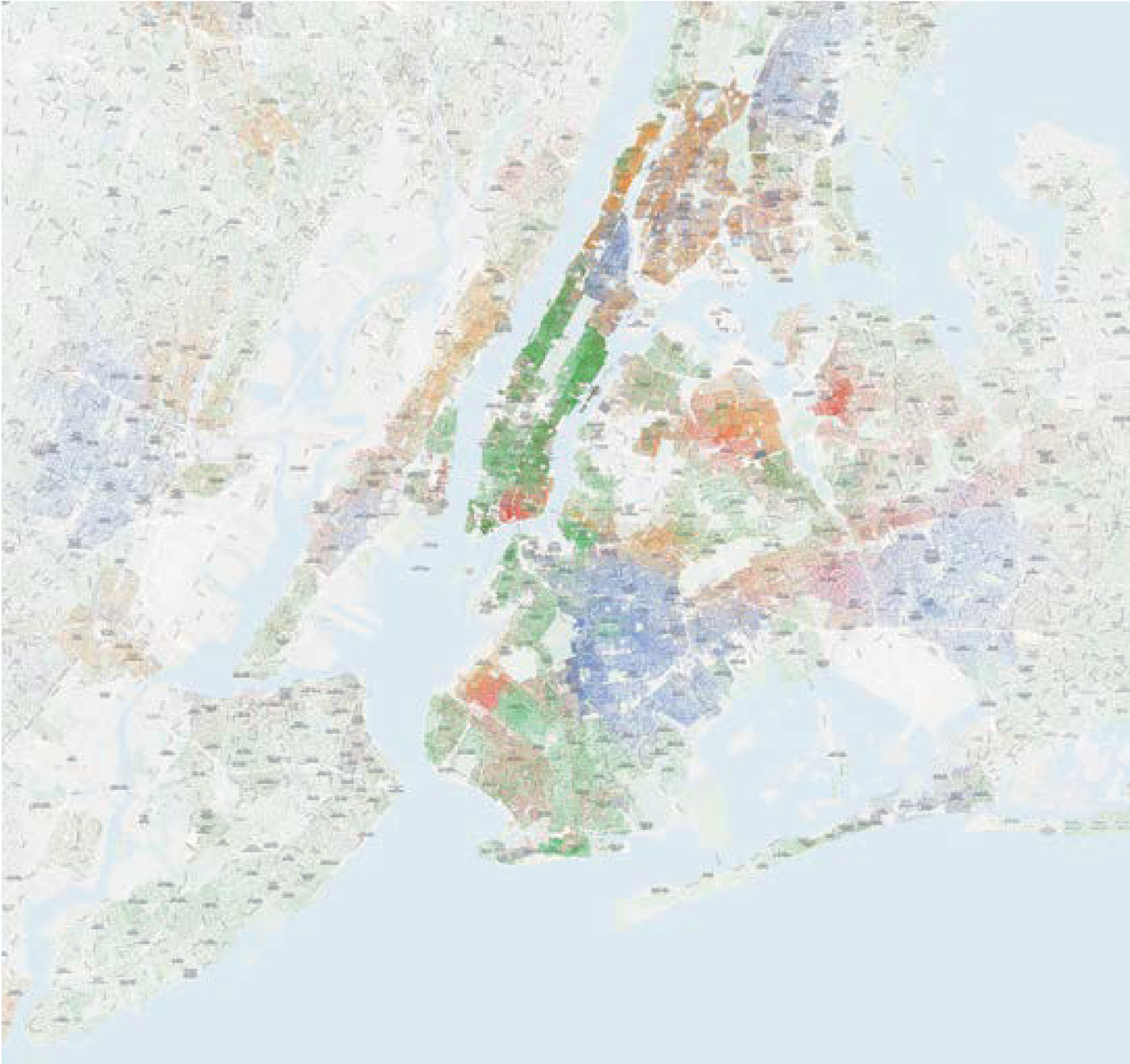

One dot = 120 people

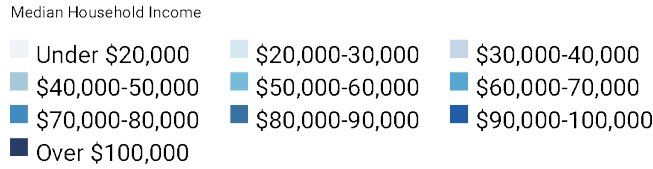
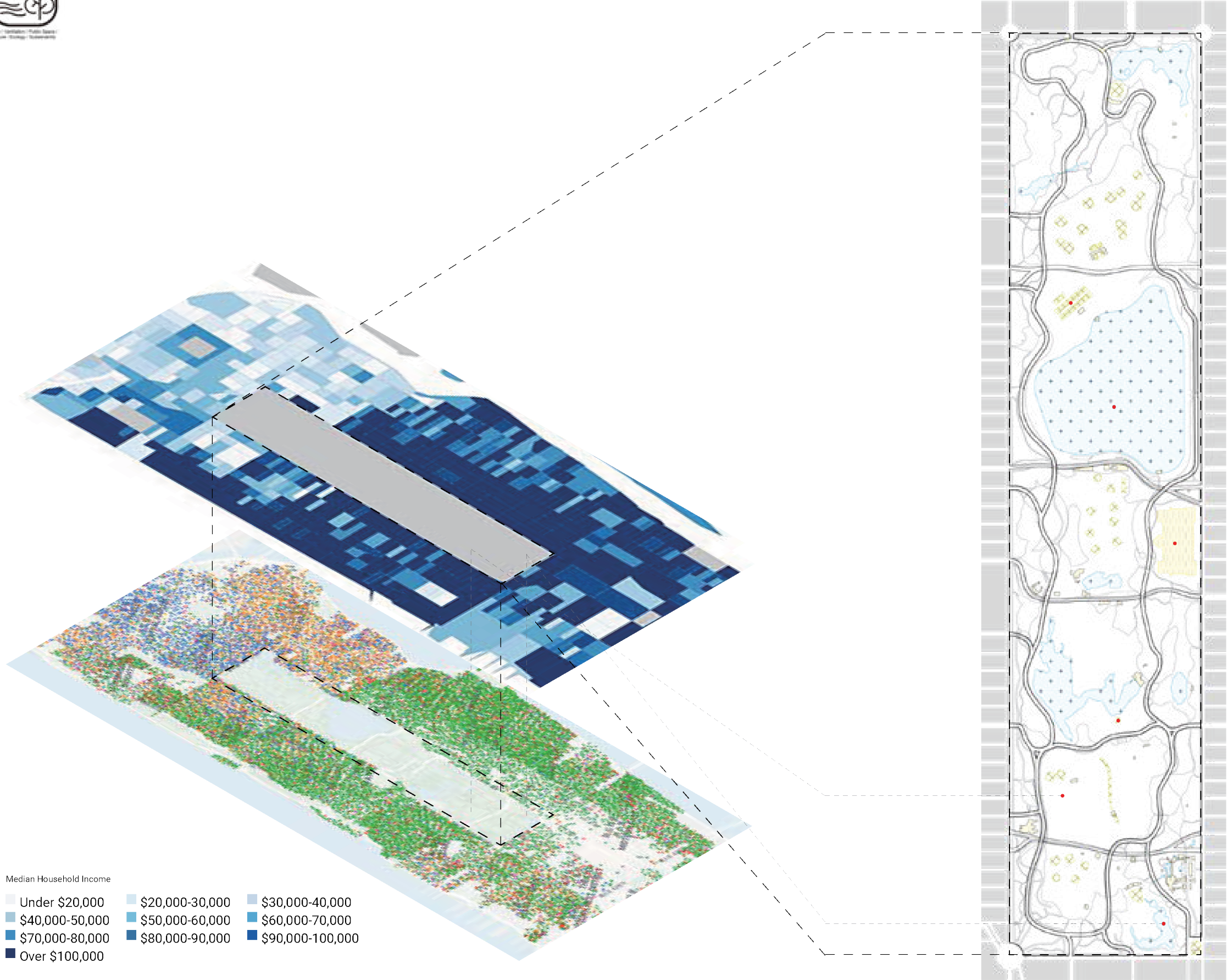
● Black ● Hispanic ● Asian ● White ● Others

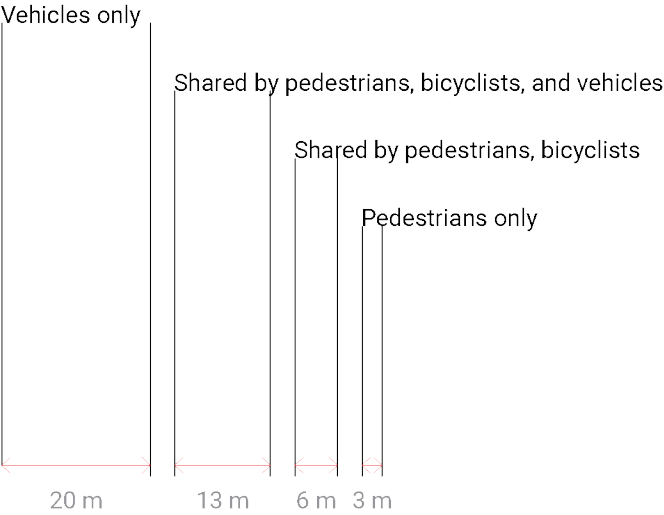


Entrances

Mainly consist of ramps



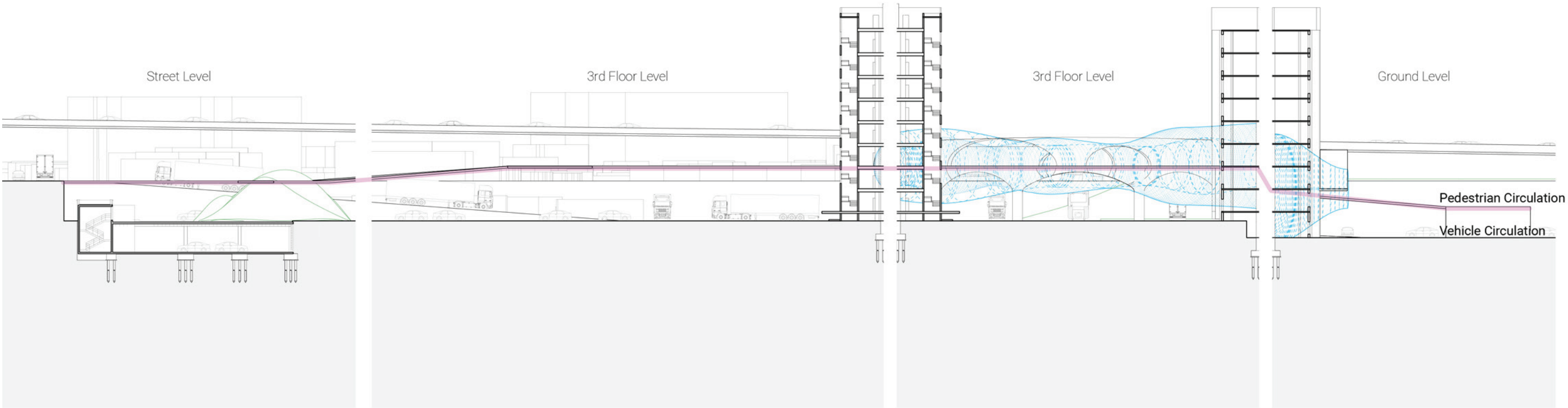
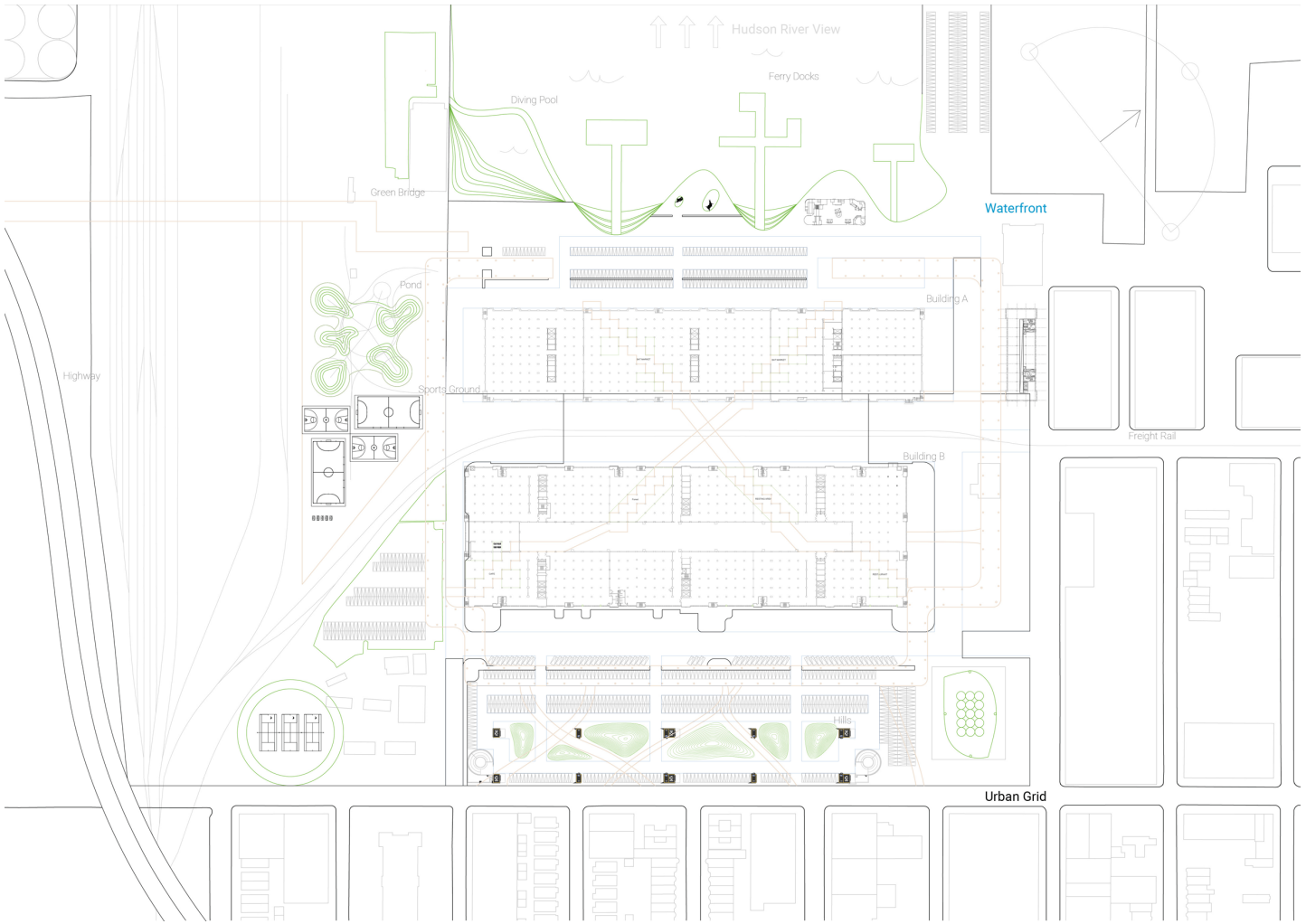
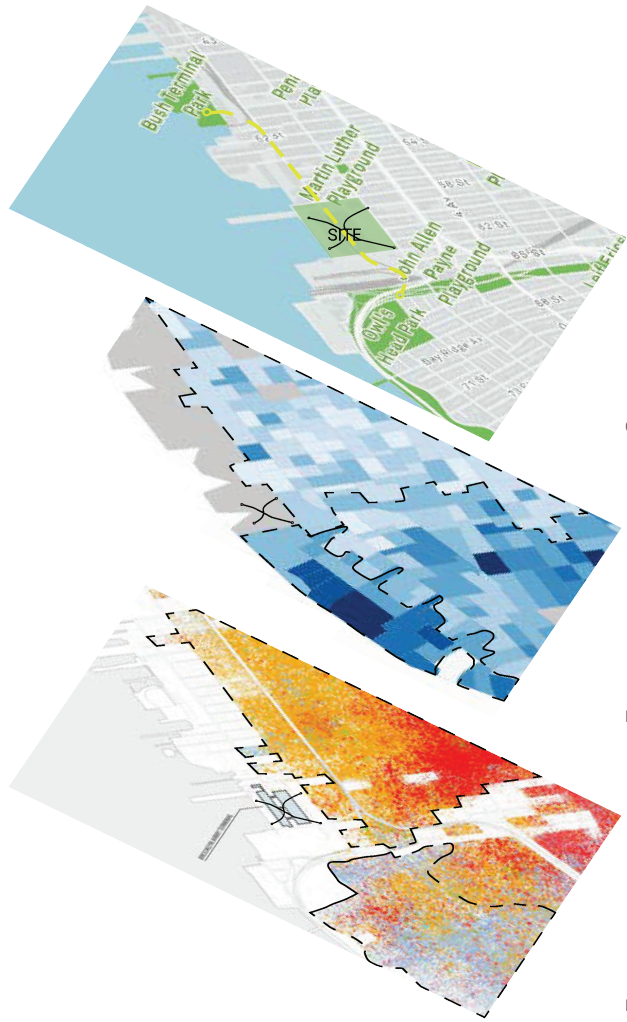

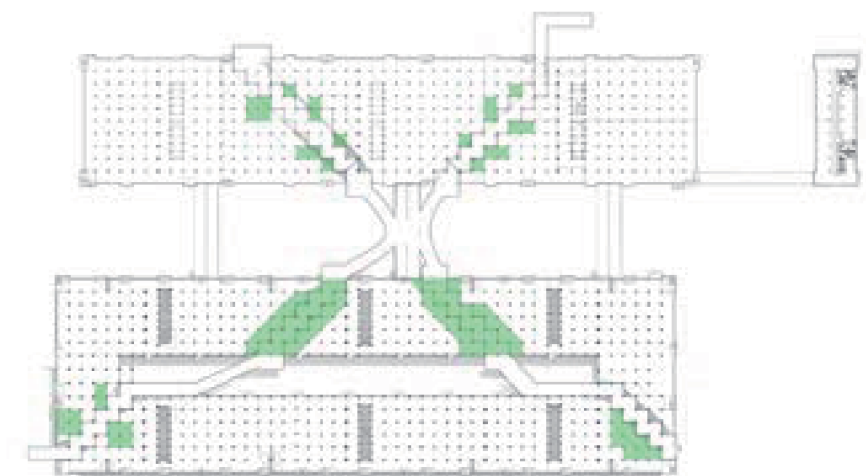
Excavating existing concrete boxes
