Write a shell script that exit on error and displays commands as they will execute, including all expansions and substitutions. Use 3 **Is** commands in your script. Make the first one succeed, the second one fail, and the third one succeed. If you are using the proper options, the third **Is** command will not be executed.

Exercise 2:

Modify the previous exercise so that script continues, even if an error occurs. This time all three **Is** commands will execute.
