100% of Minds Matter of Los Angeles graduates have been accepted to a four-year college or university. Over the past two years, four of our students have been awarded prestigious Gates Millennium scholarships.

Minds Matter students demonstrate impressive results, averaging over a 300 point improvement in their SAT score, and score 20 to 40 points higher than benchmarks on the five key areas critical for college success:¹

- Ability to write clearly and effectively
- Time management
- Ability to communicate
- Capacity for critical thinking
- Motivation to succeed



Our students enroll as sophomores, and for three years, spend every Saturday throughout the school year developing skills and enhancing academic performance necessary to prepare for college success and beyond.

The Minds Matter program includes:

- · Math, Writing, and Critical Thinking tutoring
- Standardized test preparation
- Two dedicated mentors per student
- Formal leadership development
- Financial literacy training
- Life skills workshops and outside speakers
- Participation in leading academic summer programs around the country and world
- Guidance through college admissions, the financial aid processes, and applying for scholarships

As part of the Minds Matter program, students attend academically challenging summer programs at leading colleges and universities. These summer programs provide an unparalleled opportunity for our students to experience, first-hand, what it is like to live on a college campus and take university level courses.
