LOCATION

The small but historic village of Otterburn lies approximately 30 miles north west from the regional centre of Newcastle upon Tyne. Otterburn stands on one of the main arterial routes to the Scottish Borders and the village offers a range of local amenities on the doorstep of both the Northumberland National Park and Kielder Forest Park.

DESCRIPTION

The former working men's club and institute is now closed and in a state of disrepair. The property includes an attached cottage/bungalow previously occupied by the steward and which presents an immediate opportunity for refurbishment and either sale or rental with residential use.

The site extends in total to around 1 acre with housing around three sides of the site. The eastern aspect is across a small wooded dene with a tributary of the River Rede descending from a waterfall close to the north east corner.
