

Hummingbird Happiness Supply List

Watercolor paper

I use a single sheet of Canson Cold Press 140-lb watercolor paper, but you may use any brand watercolor paper or mixed media paper.

Watercolor Paint

I use Ken Oliver Color Burst Watercolor Powder, but you can use any water-soluble paints, or crayons. If using watercolor powder (any brand) also have a few small bottle caps to mix some of the powder with water.

Printer/Copy Paper

Black & White Printer or access to one

Pencil

Ruler

White Eraser

Water

Paint Brushes, several sizes including 1 very thin brush

Paper Towels

Hummingbird Transfer Drawing

If using transfer, you will need a black and white printer with ink and 8.5"x11" printer paper.

Artists wanting to create this painting using their own style or wanting to try making this with alternate materials are encouraged. Use what you have. Make this hummingbird how you want. Different colors, types of paint, using collage, your own drawing, etc.

I encourage you to watch each lesson in full, then gather your supplies, especially if you are using different materials than I am. You can re-watch and pause the videos while you are creating your Hummingbird Happiness painting.
