**Regionals:** Friday \*13<sup>th</sup> October \* Alternate date can be arranged by regions with Squash & Racquetball Victoria

**State Finals:** Friday 27<sup>th</sup> October **Venue:** Melbourne Sports & Aquatic Centre (MSAC)

#### **FORMAT & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- 1. Each team will comprise 3 players (grades 3 to 6 students), separate teams for boys/ girls.
- 2. School teams will compete in a round robin competition.
- 3. Matches will be 3 games of 10 minutes each, point-a-rally scoring until time runs out. If the score is level at end of time, a sudden death point will be played to determine the winner.
- 4. Total **matches** won will determine the winner. If two or more teams are tied on matches won, then the team that has won the most number of games will be declared the winner. If there is still a tie, then the team who has won the most number of points will be declared the winner. If there is still a tie, then the winner of the match between the two tied teams will be declared the winner.
- 5. Matches will be played in accordance to the Australian Racquetball rules. The rules can be viewed at: <a href="https://www.squashvic.com.au">www.squashvic.com.au</a> under the racquetball menu.
- 6. Players will be required to score/ referee the match following their own.
- 7. Some equipment will be provided.
- 8. Protective eyewear that complies with Squash Australia policy is compulsory for all players competing in this competition and must be worn for the duration of all practice and matches.
- 9. Competitors must be dressed in their school sports uniform or acceptable racquetball attire. Non marking soled sports shoes must be worn.
- 10. Schools may enter as many teams as they wish.
- 11. Cost is \$40 per team. This covers each team for all rounds of competition, including state finals for qualifying teams.
- 12. The competition organisers (Squash & Racquetball Victoria and their officers, employees or agents) shall not be liable for any death or personal injury, loss of or damage to property sustained or incurred by any person in connection with the competition howsoever caused.
- 13. The competition director reserves the right to;
  - a) accept or refuse any entry
  - b) disqualify any player for late arrival or misconduct
  - c) combine events
  - d) alter match times
  - e) vary conditions of play
- 14. School team entries are to be submitted by Friday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2017 (details at bottom).
