The New Testament introduces us to the Lord Jesus Christ and the first our books are known as THE GOSPELS. They are:

- Matthew, Luke, Romans, John
- Matthew, Mark, Luke, John
- Matthew, Mark, Hebrews, John

You now know eight books of the New Testament. Repeat their names from memory before going on.

Question

Four shorter letters (or epistles) follow, all written by the Apostle Paul, giving further teaching arid practical advice to a number of churches. These are:

- James, 1 & 2 Peter, Colossians, Jude
- Philippians, Colossians, Jude, Revelation
- Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians

3. WRONG



We've already had Romans - Paul's first major treatise.

Jude was not written by Paul, but by Jude himself.

4. ALMOST CORRECT



Leviticus is out of order. This is one of the first five books of the Bible written by Moses and should already be known to you.

5. INCORRECT



We've already had Joshua and Judges.

6. ABSOLUTELY

CORRECT 🗡

You are doing very well indeed. Stop and repeat the names of all the books in the New Testament to refresh your memory -27 in all:

- ► Gospels (4)
- ► Church History (1)
- ► Paul's first major Treatise (1)
- Practical letters to the church in Corinth (2)
- Shorter letters to churches in Asia (4)
- Special teaching on Second Coming of Christ (2)
- Letters to Pastors (3)
- Paul's final epistles (2)
- Short epistles by four different men (7)
- Prophecy (1)

Now repeat the names of Old Testament books learned up to this point:

Right. Now we're moving to the PROPHETICAL SECTION - 5 major and 12 Minor Prophets. Note that the words "major" and "minor" have only to do with the length of their work, and not the importance. All Scripture is inspired by God (2 Tim. 3:16) and every book equally important.

The longest and possibly best known prophetical book (the first major prophet) has 66 chapters and is called by some a "Miniature Bible': It deals very especially with prophecy concerning the expected Messiah. It is:

- Jeremiah
- ► Isaiah

Repeat the names of the fourteen books you have just learned. Remember their logical sequence. It's not so hard, is it?!

Paul takes time now to write to some Pastors, advising them how best to care for the Church of Jesus Christ. Three epistles called:

Genesis is the first book of the Old Testament, and Jude is definitely not the last New Testament book. Hang your head in shame.

Titus (written by Paul) is out of order.

1 Corinthians is a letter containing practical teaching.

11. SORRY, INCORRECT



Jonah was a prophet and his book fits into the Prophetical Section.

You know 27 of the 39 Old Testament books already. Repeat them from memory.

Now we take a look at the MINOR PROPHETS 12 in all. Remember they are called minor only because their books are short.

- Daniel, Hosea, Amos
- ► Hosea, Joel, Arnos



Name the first five books of the Bible (The Pentateuch) in order before continuing.

Now we turn to the Early History of .Israel... from the death of Moses to just before the period of the first king (Saul). This is called the Period of the Judges (they ruled or 'judged' Israel).

The early history of Israel is covered in three books, one of which is named after a lady. They are:

The Christian Church has been established and now Paul gives some further teaching and practical advice in two letters written to the same congregation. They are fairly lengthy letters (or epistles) dealing with a number. of subjects, and especially famous for the renowned chapter on love.

They are:

- ► 1 & 2 Thessalonians
- ► 1 & 2 Peter
- ► 1 & 2 Corinthians

Jude's epistle was written by Jude himself, and not by Paul.

17. NEARLY RIGHT



However, the two books named after ladies do not belong here. We had Ruth earlier and Esther comes much later.

18. NOT A GOOD GUESS



1,2,3 John was written by the Apostle John, not by Paul.

19. NO, WRONG



Job is the oldest book in the Bible, although not placed first. His book falls into the Poetical Section - but only because of the way it is written. It deals with historical fact.



Repeat the SIX Minor Prophets you have learned - in order.

QUESTION

Name the next three Minor Prophets

- Nahum, Habakkuk, Zephaniah
- ► Joel, Habakkuk, Joshua
- Zephaniah, Ecclesiastes, Isaiah

21. WRONG



Romans is not a "Gospel" Back



QUESTION

We have two more books in the POETICAL SECTION. These are:

- Proverbs and Leviticus
- Psalms and Proverbs
- Psalms and Lamentations

23. CAUGHT YOU!



There is no book called "Moses" – Moses wrote the first five books of the Bible, known as the Pentateuch, but none of them bear his name.

24. NOT QUITE SO EASY



James was written by the Apostle James; 1 & 2 Peter by the Apostle Peter; and Jude by Jude.

25. YOU ARE DOING



QUESTION

Name two more Major Prophets especially well known for their prophecies concerning the future. They are:

- Ezekiel and Daniel
- Jeremiah and Joshua
- Daniel and Jonah

26. WRONG



1 Kings deals (as the title suggests) with the kings of Israel. We're still in its early history. Esther is also the wrong lady she lived much later.

27. NO



You've already had Isaiah.

Joshua belongs to the Historical Section.

28. A GOOD TRY, BUT INCORRECT



Haggai and Zechariah were prophets and they belong to the Prophetical Section of the Old Testament.

Ruth belongs to the Period of the Judges as you have already learned!

29. NO, NO



John wrote these three epistles, and not Paul.

30. NO



You should start this course again.

31. A GOOD TRY, BUT WRONG



Revelation deals with the future.

32. NO



You've already had Ecclesiastes (Poetical Section).

33. ABSOLUTELY NOT



Matthew is the first Gospel of the New Testament.

34. EXCELLENT

You have learned the names of the four Gospels, one Early Church historical record, and 14 epistles written by the Apostle Paul. Can you name them quickly - in order?

(Note that some Bible scholars feel that Paul did not write Hebrews but, for the purposes of this course, we will accept that he is the author).

The last seven epistles in the New Testament were written by four different men and their writings carry their names. They are:

Almost right, but these come later.

Repeat the eight Old Testament books learned so far (in order).

The next stage in the history of Israel deals with the period of the kings - from the man anointed to be the first king of Israel (Saul) to the end of their reign. Six books tell us the story. They are:

- ► 1 & 2 Samuel, 1 & 2 Kings, Joshua, Judges
- ► 1 & 2 Samuel, 1 & 2 Kings, 1 & 2 Chronicles
- ► 1 & 2 Chronicles, 1 & 2 Samuel. Esther. Ruth

Jonah is out of order. He is a Minor Prophet.

38 INCORRECT



Hebrews is out of place - it is an epistle and not a Gospel.

39. WRONG



You have already learned Zechariah, Joel, and Hosea.

40. NOT SUCH A GOOD GUESS!



Malachi is the last book of the Old Testament.

41. YOU ARE DOING VERY WELL INDEED



Repeat those last four books (in order).

Now repeat all 12 books learned.

4 Gospels

- 1 Church History

- 2 Practical Epistles
- 4 Shorter Epistles

Paul now gives some special teaching about the Return of the Lord Jesus Christ. Found in:

We move now into the third section of the Old Testament - POETICAL - 5 Books. The first is the oldest book in the Bible and deals with the Problem of Pain and Suffering. It is:

Isaiah (Prophetical) and Song of Solomon (Poetical) should already be known by you.

Hebrews is also a treatise on the Christian faith, but not Paul's first. This one comes much later.

However, Daniel is a major prophet and we are concentrating on Minor Prophets right now.

46. RIGHT 🗡

I'm glad you knew that. By the end of this course you will know all 66 books of the Bible in their correct order (39 in the O.T. and 27 in the N.T.). To help you, please remember that the Old Testament is divided into three main sections.

- Historical (covering man's beginnings to the death of Moses; Early history taking us to the period of the kings of Israel; then the period of the kings; and finally the later history).
- 2. Poetical Section.
- 3. Prophetical Section.

Now the hard part. Name the first five books of the Bible. These were written by Moses and are known as the Pentateuch.

You are making good progress.

Jeremiah is not the prophet we have in mind He is placed second in the listing of Major Prophets.

Titus (written by Paul) is out of order. $\underline{\mathsf{Back}}$

54. WRONG



You have already had Jonah and Amos.



Can you repeat them from memory and in order?

The next book is also an historical one - telling us what happened after Jesus ascended to Heaven and how His followers set about spreading the Gospel. This book is called:

Repeat the books in order.

Two books are named after men who set out to rebuild Jerusalem after its destruction by her enemies, leaving God's people exiled in Babylon. The third book in this section (Historical later history) bears the name of a lady who lived at the same time and saved the Jews from annihilation. They are:

- Haggai, Zechariah, Ruth
- Ezra, Job, Ruth

These books were written by the Apostle Peter.

63. INCORRECT



Isaiah is a Major Prophet.

64. WRONG AGAIN



Revelation was written by the Apostle John

65. FIRST CLASS

Repeat the names of the books you have learned to this point - in order.

4 Gospels, 1 Church History, 1 Major Treatise, 6 Epistles (two long and four Shorter), 2 epistles teaching about the Second Coming and 3 written to Pastors).

The historical side has been dealt with, and now the Apostle Paul writes his first book -a treatise on the Christian faith addressed to Christians in one of the major cities of the world of his time. It is called:

- Romans
- ► Hebrews
- ► John

72. A GOOD TRY



... but Amos is out of order. He was a prophet who wrote much later than Moses and his book bears his name.

73. OH NO! YOU'RE GUESSING



Revelation is the last book in the New Testament.

74. A GOOD GUESS, BUT INCORRECT



Jeremiah suffered very deeply, but he is a prophet and fits into our third Old Testament category - Prophetical.

75. A GOOD GUESS



However, Jude and Revelation were written by the Apostles Jude and John respectively, and not Paul.



QUESTION

The next two books were written by one man - known as "The Weeping Prophet - and deal with prophecy concerning the coming exile of Israel to Babylon. These are:

- Isaiah and Song of Solomon
- Jeremiah and Lamentations
- ► Ezekiel and Ecclesiastes

Repeat the nine Minor Prophets you have learned from memory and in order.

The last three Minor Prophets are:

- Haggai, Jonah, Amos
- Zechariah, Joel, Hosea




